
OUR MISSION

2022 was a year of recovery and growth. Thank you for your support in helping us make sure we were ready to meet the needs of our passengers, their families, and our healthcare and nonprofit partners. As we emerge from the pandemic, health care is forever changed. But thanks to your help, we were able to serve 500 more people than in the previous year and flew 4,600 missions and completed 1,383 Earth Angel ground trips.

As always, we focused on learning from our passengers, partners, and volunteers, as we worked together to course correct toward a more equitable future. We never lost track of our goal to create greater access to health care and hope for our passengers, one flight at a time. Our flight plan included expanding our team, honing our technology, introducing Spanish language outreach, and getting back to in-person fundraising events. During the holiday season, our volunteers collected and delivered gifts to 25 families in need, and to elementary students at a Title I school in Utah. And we ended the year by receiving The President's Volunteer Service Award from the White House in recognition of our volunteers and their service to others.

This success reflects the dedication and determination of our incredible Angel Flight West team: our volunteers, staff, board, partners, and supporters. Together we're changing lives through the gift of flight. The runway is cleared for a landmark year ahead, when we'll celebrate 40 years of service and our 100,000th donated flight. We couldn't have accomplished any of this without our community of support and the hard work and dedication of so many. Thank you for being the wind under our wings.








TOTAL EXPENSES



THE BOND BETWEEN PILOT AND PASSENGER

As a volunteer pilot with Angel Flight West (AFW) since 2014, Chris has flown 574 missions to help passengers travel to far-off care. In 2022, Chris was our top flyer, completing an incredible 78 flights.


Chris' aviation journey began more than 10 years ago. "As soon as I earned my pilot certificate in 2012, I was completely seduced," he says. Intrigued by the idea of charitable aviation, Chris soon signed up to volunteer for AFW. "This organization has given me the opportunity to help people in tangible ways," he says. "It's been very rewarding."

The special relationships formed through his gifts of flight have been long lasting. He's flown numerous passengers dozens – and some even hundreds – of times. One of those frequent flyers Is Eileen from Atwater, Calif. Every Friday, Chris meets Eileen at her local airport to fly her to Merced for her appointments at San Carlos Medical Center. Since 2016, the duo has taken to the skies 230 times. "It's a privilege to be involved in her life," Chris says. "And our paths may have never crossed if not for Angel Flight West."

Pictured above, Tiffany was another of Chris' repeat passengers. Born with cystic fibrosis, Tiffany was a double-lung transplant recipient who bravely fought for and warmly embraced life. Over the past five years, Chris welcomed Tiffany onto his Diamond Star aircraft 45 times to get her to and from critical care. "Tiffany was relentless in her zest for life," says Chris. "It was centering to spend time with her, and I truly enjoyed her friendship."

Tiffany passed away a few months after their last flight together, but we're humbled by the friendship the two formed in between their takeoffs and landings. "I'll be telling people about Tiffany for the rest of my life," he says.
