More about Cathy: Cathy Johnson, aka The YES I CAN Coach, has been an entrepreneur for 30+ years. She published a well-loved community magazine for families for 20 years, while also producing multiple events each year. She sold the magazine in 2015 and stepped into full-time coaching as a certified life and business coach. During the pandemic, Cathy felt called to bring more of her faith and spiritual practices into her coaching and added a spiritual leadership coach certification as well.

Cathy has written numerous books based on her coaching method, been featured on [cbs.com](https://www.cbs.com), interviewed on KFWB radio, nominated for the Los Angeles Business Journal "Women Making a Difference" award and received the President's Call to Service Life-Time Achievement Award for her philanthropic work. Cathy has lived most of her life in

the South Bay of Southern CA, has 3 grown children, and has recently married her soulmate. She tells her story openly and vulnerably so that others know they are not alone. She walks her talk and continues to live the YES Method daily.

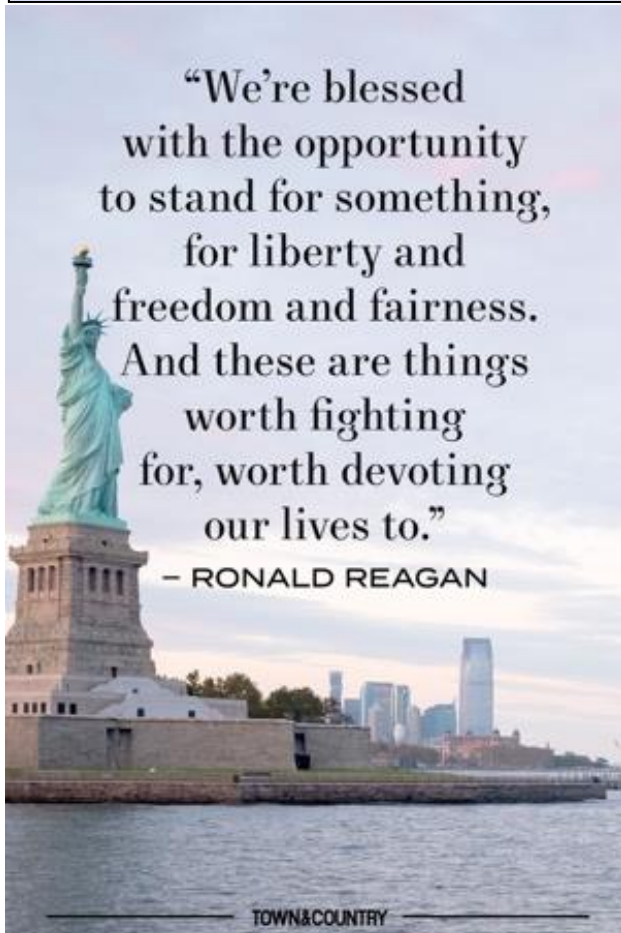


SERVICE LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS UPDATE

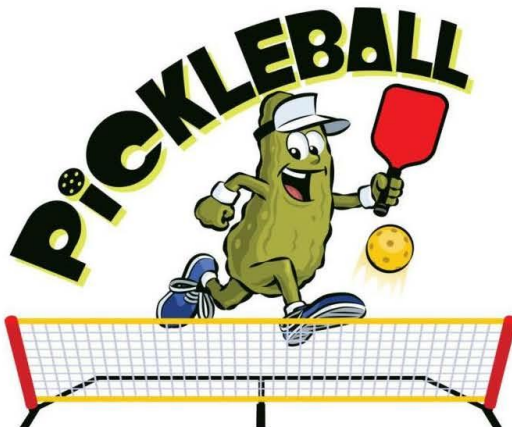

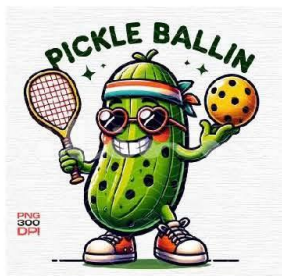
